# **Description:**

Not only will the winning design be printed on official library cards, but the winning teen will also earn a \$50 cash gift card! # **Rules and Regulations:**

- 1. Must be in grades 6-12 and an E.D. Locke Public Library cardholder.
- 2. Only one entry per contestant.
- 3. All entries must be completed on an official application, either available at E.D. Locke Public Library or on our website: <a href="mailto:mcfarlandlibrary.org/teen">mcfarlandlibrary.org/teen</a>
- 4. Dimensions for entries must be 3.375"x2.125" (a template for these dimensions can be found on the application).
- 5. The submitted entry must be the creative and original work of a single individual (no copies or artwork created by other people). No AI may be used to create your image.
- 6. Artwork must be 2d, but can include digital or physical media. Acceptable digital formats include JPEG, PNG, and PDF. All submissions must be high resolution (300 dpi).
- 7. By submitting a work to this contest, you entitle E.D. Locke Public Library to use it in perpetuity, including with any modifications we deem necessary for our use.
- 8. By participating in the contest, participants are agreeing to abide by the rules and the decisions made by the judging panel.
- 9. The deadline for submissions is Friday, April 4th.

### **Theme**

We are looking for designs that answer the question "What do you love about E.D. Locke Public Library?" Your design could also display:

- How books inspire you
- How libraries inspire you
- How E.D. Locke Public Library makes your life better

### **Prizes:**

The winning design will be used for official library cards and for library promotional materials, and the winning designer will receive a \$50 cash gift card. The winning designer and their design will also be promoted on our social media.

- Three runner-ups will have stickers printed of their design.
- All eligible submissions will be displayed at the library for the community to see!

# **Judging Criteria:**

Submissions will be judged by how well the design showcases the library and your answer to the above question, creativity and visual impact of the design, and how well the design works within the dimensions of a library card. Judges will be various members of the McFarland community and library staff.
